



## Pure Freestyle Fun on 2900m – The Glacier Park is Calling!

Amazingly blue skies and a freshly shaped snowpark on an altitude of 2900 meters waiting to be shred. Ever since its opening, countless motivated freestylers have been crowding the Glacier Park and were rewarded with an excellent park setup as early as October! The Snowpark Kitzsteinhorn is one of the first snowparks in the Alps to welcome the new season with a sterling setup!

At the moment, the Glacier Park on the Kitzsteinhorn comprises 11 obstacles in total. Next to the Kickerline with two jumps, also a playful Railline consisting of a 4m Down Rail, a 6m Flat Rail, a 9m Single Bar Down Rail as well as a Box Line including a 6m Kicker Box, a Flat Box and a Flat Down Box of 6m each awaits all visitors. At the end of the park an additional highlight will be a bold Multi Obstacle with a Table Top Corner including a Pole Jam and a Flat Rail. But that's still not all: the setup is growing continuously and, depending on snow levels, even more sophisticated elements will be added. The Superpipe and the Easy Park are being prepared at full blast as well! *"Right now there are 15 snow cannons blasting day and night in the lower park area,"* as Snowpark Kitzsteinhorn parkdesigner Stefan Plattner comments cheerfully.

Last Sunday a Freeski Crew consisting of riders Max Brandauer, Moritz Schwarz, Niki Sagmeister, and Flo Ehgartner met up in the Snowpark Kitzsteinhorn and put both their skills and the great weather to good use in a shooting. The snowboarders were represented by Alois Lindgruber, Patrick Pitter and shredding lady Christine "Isy" Szumovski. The whole crew was stunned by the extensive setup or, in Patrick's words: "Considering that it's still October, the park is just wicked! I liked the Medium Kicker best!" Freeskier Max Brandauer was especially taken with the constellation of the obstacles: "The elements have been built carefully, pop and landing of the kickers are nicely attuned – that way you always gain enough speed."

The pictures taken at the shooting will surely give you a glimpse of the amazing atmosphere in the park. *"Thanks to the great weather, the motivated riders and the phat park setup, the atmosphere at the shooting was awesome. It always is,"* Flo enthused about the day in the park. Asked who was the winner of the day, freeskiers and snowboarders agreed to disagree, but one thing's for sure: the most wicked trick was Max Brandauer's Swith Cork 9 Mute.
